### **Admission / Registration procedures**

The admission procedure varies according to the below mentioned groups of students:

#### **Study in Czech language:**

- A pre-requisite for admission to a Bachelor study programme is a complete secondary education – Maturita (A-level).
- A pre-requisite for admission to a Master study programme is a Bachelor degree.
- A pre-requisite for admission to a Doctoral study programme is graduation from a Master's study programme.

Students studying in the Czech language do not have to pay any tuition fees in the standard length of study.

Study in English Language:

- A pre-requisite for admission to a Bachelor study programme is a complete secondary education – Maturita (A-level).
- A pre-requisite for admission to a Master study programme is a Bachelor degree.
- A pre-requisite for admission to a Doctoral study programme is graduation from a Master's study programme.

Students studying in the English/German language are required to pay a tuition fee as determined by the relevant faculty.

For instance, the graduates will be also prepared for accepting different jobs in the area where language is required as a means of communication (employees in the sphere of culture, translators in numerous areas of our economic system, assistants to teachers in numerous EU countries, etc.)
